We had a record 13=1. This season, we were ranked one of the best 6-man defenses in the State, only allowing 18 points per game. During non-district play, we beat 9-time UIL State Champion Richland Springs 64-32. Richland went on to play for a State Semi-Final Game in 2021. Also, we won many high-ranked private school teams this season, which 1 of them played for a Division 1 State Championship.

In Basketball (my 1st Year, 2020, on the boy's side), we made it to the Regional Finals and lost to the team that won State. In 2021, we made it to the State Semi-Final and lost to the team that won State.
